Individually Directed Petrents

Individually Directed Retreats provide a quiet space to pray and reflect on God's Word at your own pace and schedule. This is a time of sacred silence, an invitation to step away from the pressures and demands of daily life to listen to God and notice where God is moving in your life. You are accompanied by a trained spiritual director who will meet with you daily during the retreat, offering guidance for the next day's prayer based on the spiritual exercises of St. Ignatius.

These sessions allow for four-to-eight-day retreats (minimum of four full consecutive days/maximum of eight full consecutive days within session dates/times).

Arrival time begins at 5:00 PM on the opening date of the retreat session, dinner is at 6:00 PM and the retreat itself begins at 7:30 PM. The retreat ends at 10:00 AM on the closing date of the retreat session.
