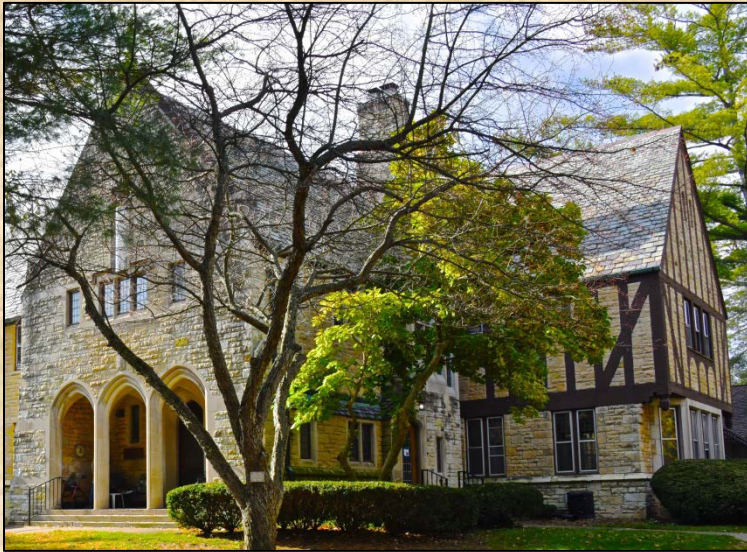


# *An Afternoon Reflection at Manresa*

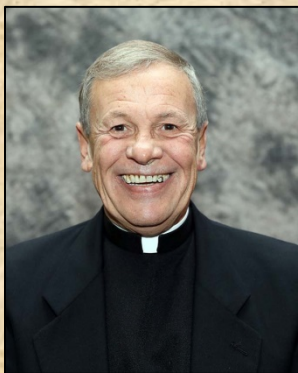
