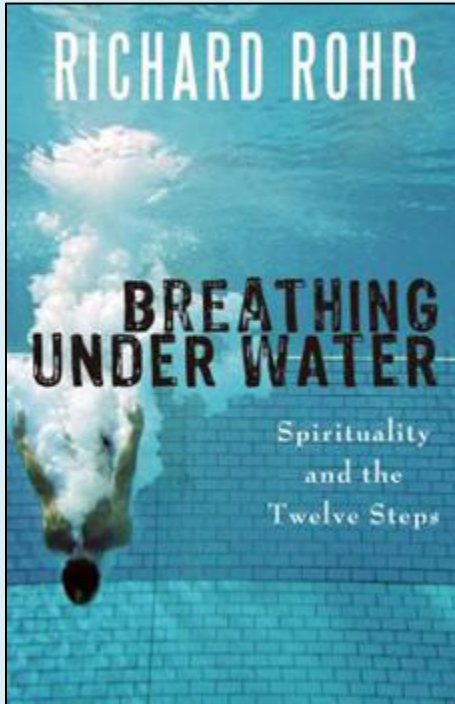


A Book Study with Deacon Carroll

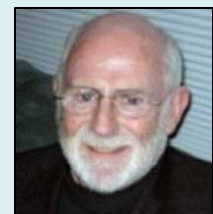
Sessions will be available onsite only in Manresa's Wernert Lounge.
